ORDER RESCINDING LIMITATION ON IN-PERSON PROCEEDINGS

Due to an outbreak of COVID-19 at the Prince William County Adult Detention Center (ADC), the Court entered Orders on May 25, 2020 and June 4, 2020 temporarily suspending in-person hearings in the Circuit Court and District Courts of the Thirty-First Judicial Circuit for inmates incarcerated at the Prince William County ADC. Said Orders were to be effective from May 26, 2020 until June 28, 2020.

It appearing that the number of inmates who are positive for COVID-19 has now significantly decreased and health and safety protocols have been implemented by the ADC, it is

ORDERED that the limitation on in-person hearings is hereby rescinded effective June 22, 2020. Notwithstanding the rescission of the limitation on in-person hearings, unless otherwise ordered by the presiding judge, arraignments, to-be-set hearings and bond motions in the Circuit Court shall continue to be conducted by audio-visual means until further Order of the Court.
