REQUIREMENTS FOR MEMBERSHIP

The by-laws of the Prince William County Bar Association, Inc. (PWC Bar) provide that applicants for **Regular Membership** must meet the following requirements:

- (a) Must be an attorney who is a member in good standing of the Virginia State Bar, who is lawfully licensed to practice law; and
- (b) Must maintain a *bona fide* office for private practice within the area encompassed by the jurisdiction of the Circuit Court of Prince William County, (31st Judicial Circuit); **OR** be employed as a lawyer by a Federal or State Government, or be employed by a private organization, within the 31st Judicial Circuit; **OR** maintain a substantial portion of his or her practice at the time of application within the 31st Judicial Circuit; **OR** maintain his or her residence within the 31st Judicial Circuit; and
- (c) Must be sponsored in writing by two Regular Members in good standing of the PWC Bar Association; and
- (d) Must pay annual dues, \$100 for 0-3 years in practice, \$200.00 for 4 or more years in practice. (Membership dues are not pro-rated. Renewal notices are sent in December each year.)

Associate Member. If you meet the above-mentioned criteria, (c-d), but are currently licensed in another state and/or jurisdiction, you are eligible to become an Associate Member, but do not have the right to vote.

Senior Member. If you are a current regular member but are over 60 years of age and are not engaged in practice full time, you are eligible to become a Senior Member and maintain your voting privileges. Senior members pay annual dues of \$75.00.

Student Member. If you are a student enrolled at an ABA accredited law school, you are eligible for a Student Membership, but do not have the right to vote. Applicants for Student Member require only one regular member sponsor and must pay annual dues of \$25.00.

Para-Professional Member. If you are a non-attorney to include paralegal, legal assistant, legal secretary, clerk, or case manager working as an employee of a Prince William County legal practice or law firm, Prince William County Courthouse or Virginia State or Local Government offices of the 31st Judicial Circuit you are eligible for a para-professional membership, but do not have the right to vote. Applicants for Para-Professional Membership require two regular member sponsors and must pay annual dues of \$50.00.
