Court Appointed Attorney

Attorney is qualified by the VAIDC and accepts appointments for indigent defense through the courts.

Modest Means Program

Volunteer accepts prequalified referrals through LSNV or the GDC Courts and provides reduced fee legal services.

Domestic Violence Program

Volunteer accepts referrals from ACTS Turning Points Domestic Violence Shelter who are prequalified through LSNV and provides pro bono representation for protective orders. Free CLE training is provided annually.

Uncontested Divorce Project

Volunteer provides pro bono representation to prequalified clients seeking uncontested divorces through LSNV. Free CLE training is provided annually.

Expungement Clinic

Volunteer works with LSNV to provide advice or pro bono representation to prequalified clients identified through LSNV who are seeking expungement assistance. Free CLE training is provided annually.

Circuit Court Conciliators

Volunteer agrees to act as a conciliator, resolving discovery disputes in PWC Circuit Court on a rotating schedule.

J&DR Conciliators

Volunteer agrees to act as a conciliator, resolving custody, visitation & support disputes in PWC JDR District Court on a rotating schedule.
